Permit Conditions

1. Permittee's engagement in any activities under this permit shall constitute an acceptance of these provisions and the applicable CID discharge requirements.
2. Permittee shall place any equipment to perform discharge at own risk and in a manner to avoid damages to CID infrastructure. Permittee is responsible for any damages to CID infrastructure relating to the discharge activities.
3. Permittee certifies that the discharged waters are free from contaminants that may persist in soils or otherwise not be authorized under CID's NPDES permit.
4. A copy of the approved permit and any drawings describing the work shall be kept at the site during the work.
5. All work on CID rights of way shall be completed in accordance with CID standard specifications. Following completion of the permitted work the right of way shall be left clean and free of all debris, waste and other undesirable materials.
6. This Permit shall not be amended or revised except by the written consent of all parties.
7. This Permit shall be construed and enforced pursuant to the laws of the State of Washington. Venue for any action brought relating to this Permit or the enforcement of the terms hereof, shall be in the Superior Court of Washington, in and for Benton County.
8. If any party to this Permit waives a breach of one or more of the provisions of this Permit by any other party, that waiver shall neither operate nor be construed as a waiver of a subsequent similar breach of any provision hereof.
9. Storage and/or disposal of any hazardous material(s) or hazardous waste(s) on the CID right of way is expressly forbidden.
